Pastor's
Corner

IN THE BELLY OF THE WHALE

If you want to read a short book within the Bible, one that can be read in 15 minutes, choose the Book of the Prophet Jonah. It is much like a parable, intended to teach in a lively and sometimes amusing way. It teaches that even the most unpromising of God's threats is an expression of His merciful will, who pardons at the first sign of repentance. God's mercy extends even to Israel's most detested enemy, Babylon, who today is named Baghdad! In two and a half pages, the story of Jonah illustrates the major steps of the spiritual life: God's call, the refusal of Jonah to obey, the purification of Jonah (in the belly of the fish), the anger of Jonah toward God, the mercy of God for Jonah and his enemies.

We can identify with the questions of Jonah. How could God ask me to work for the salvation of my arch enemy? Why God uses the constraints of life (the belly of the fish) to bring me back to the place where I was supposed to go? The answer is that all the purification is meant to help me reach that place and state of being where "the slightest cooperation with God's grace can provoke a massive spiritual change" for me and for those I am sent to, as Fr. Barron said in his homily 570.

This is indeed what happened to Nineveh. All turned to God! What is your Nineveh? Here is a prayer to help you. It was composed by John Henry Newman, then a prominent Anglican priest, returning from Rome and finally deciding to join the Roman Catholic Church. He became one of its greatest leaders: Blessed Cardinal John H. Newman.

Lead, kindly Light, amid the encircling gloom,
 Lead Thou me on!
 The night is dark, and I am far from home—
 Lead Thou me on!
