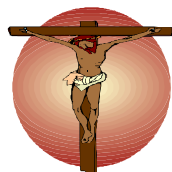
IS GOD DEAF? OR IS IT ME?

The recent tragedies of Haiti, Chile and France led some of us to question God's goodness and God's providence. Does he really care about what is happening in the world? Today's first reading invites us to answer "yes" to this question. God told Moses that he heard the cries of his people and he will do something about it. But he will not do it with a magic wand. He said to Moses; *"You do something about it, and I will be with you."* God is telling us the same thing when we complain about the suffering of the world and accuse Him of doing nothing. God answers; *"Yes, I did something about it, I created you. I have given you talents and gifts and I will give you special charisms, and guidance, so that you may do the right things at the right times. If you only trusted me, as much as my Son trusts me".* **Let us join in the effort of Development and Peace in helping the Third World.**

Another question may arise in our mind as we ponder the disasters of Haiti, Chile and France. What have they done to be "punished" like this? Jesus answers in today's Gospel that they are not more guilty than us and He doesn't blame God the Father. He says we are all guilty. The surprising thing is that we do not **all** perish, because we all deserve it (*see the Magnificat Lenten Companion, page 29*).

As in today's parable of the fig tree, the Lord gives us another chance to repent and bear good fruits with the talents and graces that He gave us and will give us. Let us amend our lives and rid ourselves of selfishness; with God's graces, so that we may do the good works He has prepared for us before the foundation of the world.
